**Description:** Rabbit polyclonal antibody

Background: ATDAO2 is an IAA oxidase expressed in root caps. It is a member of a family of

dioxygenase and 2OG Fe(II) oxygenase domain and DAO domain containing proteins. ATDAO1 is the primary constitutive mechanism of auxin catabolism in Arabidopsis and that the temporal- and tissue-specific oxidative inactivation of auxin by DAO adjusts indole-3-acetic acid levels throughout the life of the plant

to optimize growth and development.

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (16 aa from N terminal section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana DAO2 (AT1G14120).

Form: Lyophilized

**Quantity**: 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen Affinity Purified

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitution with 150 $\mu$ l of sterile 1 $\times$ PBS (PH=7.4).

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

**Stability &**Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70 °C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

**Shipping:** The product is shipped at  $4^{\circ}$ C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.
