<b>Description:</b>	Rabbit polyclonal antibody
<b>Background:</b>	Annexin (ANN) is a member of a diverse, multigene family of calcium-dependent transporters. There are eight annexins in arabidopsis: ANN1 (AT1G35720), ANN2 (AT5G65020), ANN3 (AT2G38760), ANN4 (AT2G38750), ANN5 (AT1G68090), ANN6 (AT5G10220), ANN7 (AT5G10230), ANN8 (AT5G12380).
<b>Synonyms:</b>	ANN1, ANNAT1, ANNEXIN 1, ATANN1, ATOXY5, OXY5
<b>Immunogen:</b>	KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (15 aa from C terminal section) derived from <i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i> ANN1 (AT1G35720).
<b>Form:</b>	Lyophilized
<b>Quantity:</b>	150 µg
<b>Purification:</b>	Immunogen affinity purified
<b>Reconstitution:</b>	Reconstitution with 150 µl of 0.01 M sterile PBS. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
<b>Stability &amp; Storage:</b>	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
<b>Shipping:</b>	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.

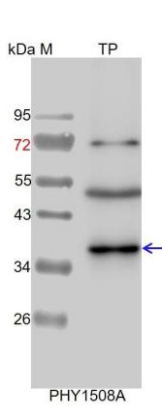
<b>Recommended Dilution:</b>	Western Blot (1:1000-1:2000) Note: Optimal dilutions/concentrations should be determined by the end user.
<b>Expected / apparent MW:</b>	36 kDa
<b>Confirmed Reactivity:</b>	<i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i>
<b>Predicted Reactivity:</b>	Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used for immunization is 100% homologues with the sequence in <i>Brassica</i>

## Application Example



TP: 20 µg total protein from *Arabidopsis thaliana*.

**Electrophoresis:** 15% SDS-PAGE

**Transfer:** blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

**Blocking:** 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

**Primary antibody:** 1:2000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

**Secondary antibody:** 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG

H&L(HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

**Detection:** using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.
