<b>Reconstitution:</b>	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
<b>Stability &amp;</b>	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
<b>Storage:</b>	12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
<b>Shipping:</b>	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.

Among species analyzed, the sequence of the synthetic peptide used for immunization is 100% homologous with the sequence in *Brassica napus*, *Physcomitrium patens*, *Glycine max*, *Medicago truncatula*, *Hordeum vulgare*, *Zea mays*, *Sorghum bicolor*, *Triticum aestivum*, *Solanum tuberosum*, *Panicum virgatum*, *Brassica rapa*, *Solanum lycopersicum*, *Gossypium raimondii*, *Cucumis sativus*, *Vitis vinifera*, *Nicotiana tabacum*, *Populus trichocarpa*, *Setaria viridis*, *Oryza sativa*.
