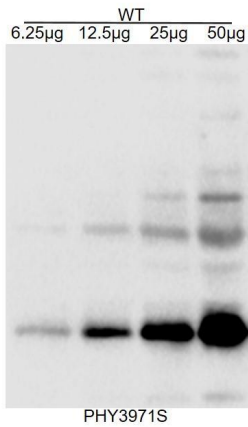
Description:	Rabbit polyclonal antibody
Background:	PYG7 is a TPR protein with homology to Ycf37 from <i>Synechocystis</i> that is localized to the thylakoid membrane and is involved in photosystem I biogenesis.
Synonyms:	PYG7
Immunogen:	Recombinant protein of PYG7 (168-301aa) derived from <i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i> AT1G22700.
Form:	Lyophilized
Quantity:	150 µg
Purification:	Serum
Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
Stability & Storage:	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.

Application Example



WT: thylakoid membrane protein from *Arabidopsis thaliana* containing 6.25 µg, 12.5 µg, 25 µg and 50 µg of chlorophyll, respectively.

Electrophoresis: 15% SDS-PAGE.

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

Blocking: 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

Primary antibody: 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

Detection: using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.
