12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70 $^\circ\!{ m C}$ as supplied.
6 months, -20 to -70 $^\circ \!$
1 month, 2 to 8 $^\circ\!{ m C}$ under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
The product is shipped at 4 $^\circ\!{ m C}$ . Upon receipt, store it immediately at the
temperature recommended above.



## **Application Example**



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 53 kDa. **Electrophoresis:** 12% SDS-PAGE **Transfer:** blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h. **Blocking:** 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h. **Primary antibody:** 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4°C. **Secondary antibody:** 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP) (Cat# PHY6000).

**Detection:** using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with CCD camera.



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
