**Description:** Rabbit polyclonal antibody

**Background:** AtINT4 is a high affinity H+:myo-inositol symporter. It mediates high-affinity

myoinositol-proton symport across the plasma membrane.

Synonyms: INT4, AtINT4, INOSITOL TRANSPORTER 4

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (14 aa from C terminal section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana INT4 (AT4G16480).

Form: Lyophilized

**Quantity:** 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen affinity purified

**Reconstitution:** Reconstitution with 150 μl of 0.01 M sterile PBS.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

**Stability &**Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70 °C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70 °C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8<sup>°</sup>C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

**Shipping:** The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

end user.



## **Application Example**



Recom: 2.5 ng, 10 ng and 25 ng recombinant protein containing the peptide for immunization and having a molecular mass of 48 kDa.

Electrophoresis: 12% SDS-PAGE

Transfer: blotting to NC (nitrocellulose) membrane for 1 h.

**Blocking:** 5% skim milk at RT or 4°C for 1 h.

**Primary antibody:** 1:1000 dilution overnight at 4℃.

Secondary antibody: 1:10000 dilution using Goat Anti-Rabbit IgG H&L (HRP)

(Cat# PHY6000).

**Detection:** using chemiluminescence substrate and image were captured with

CCD camera.
