Background: IAA1is a short-lived nuclear-localized transcriptional regulator protein.

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (14 aa from N terminal section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana IAA1 (AT4G14560).

Form: Lyophilized

Quantity: 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen affinity purified

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of 0.01 M sterile PBS.

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8℃ under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.
