Description: Rabbit polyclonal antibody

Background: PHOT1 (AT3G45780) and PHOT2 (AT5G58140) mediate blue light-dependent

activation of the plasma membrane H+-ATPase in guard cell protoplasts.

PHOT1 undergoes blue-light-dependent autophosphorylation.

Synonyms: PHOT1, JK224, NONPHOTOTROPIC HYPOCOTYL 1, NPH1,

PHOTOTROPIN 1, ROOT PHOTOTROPISM 1, RPT1

Immunogen: KLH-conjugated synthetic peptide (15 aa from N terminal section) derived from

Arabidopsis thaliana PHOT1 (AT3G45780).

Form: Lyophilized

Quantity: 150 μg

Purification: Immunogen affinity purified

Reconstitution: Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile 1XPBS (PH=7.4).

"Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might

occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".

Stability &Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.

Storage: 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70° C as supplied.

6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.

Shipping: The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the

temperature recommended above.

Recommended Dilution: Western Blot (1:1000-1:2000)
