Background:	B-box (BBX) proteins are zinc-finger transcription factors containing one or two B-box motifs. BBX proteins act as key factors in the networks regulating growth and development. BBX21 acts downstream of COP1 (AT2G32950) and play an important role in early and long-term adjustment of the shade avoidance syndrome (SAS) responses in natural environments.

Immunogen:	Recombinant protein of BBX21 (110-311 aa) derived from <i>Arabidopsis thaliana</i> AT1G75540.
Form:	Lyophilized
Quantity:	150 µg
Purification:	Serum
Reconstitution:	Reconstitution with 150 µl of sterile water. "Note: please spin tube briefly prior to opening it to avoid any losses that might occur from lyophilized material adhering to the cap or sides of the tube".
Stability & Storage:	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles. 12 months from date of receipt, -20 to -70°C as supplied. 6 months, -20 to -70°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution. 1 month, 2 to 8°C under sterile conditions after reconstitution.
Shipping:	The product is shipped at 4°C. Upon receipt, store it immediately at the temperature recommended above.
